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REQUIREMENTS & CONDITIONS

Prospective members are advised that an application for membership involves a portfolio assessment and an applicant interview, and that evidence of high standards is required. In addition, an applicant may be required to pass the Exams set by MIID as required under the Constitution.

The category of corporate membership is divided into the following classes :

- (i) Ordinary Members
- (ii) Overseas Members

Qualifications for Corporate Membership

A candidate for admission as a Corporate Member shall be a Malaysian Citizen and shall possess a qualification which the MIID Constitution and the Bye-laws may prescribe, or allow, and which is acceptable to the Council of the Institute.

(1) Ordinary Members

Subject to the requirements of the law for the time being in force (including but not limited to the Architects Act 1967), a candidate for admission as an Ordinary Member must be:-

- a person who:-
 - i) (a) holds the qualification recognised by the Board, or (b) is a Graduate Member of the Institute; and
 - ii) has obtained the practical experience as may be determined by the Board; or
- a person who is registered as an Architect under the Architects Act 1967.

(2) Overseas Members

Any Ordinary Member who, for whatever reason, intends to reside overseas for a minimum period of one (1) year or has ceased to reside in Malaysia permanently shall upon request of the Institute, using the prescribed form under the Bye-laws apply to the Council to become an Overseas Member and subject to the approval of Council, be eligible for the rights and privileges which this Constitution and the Bye-laws may prescribe or allow to an Overseas Member.
